THE Property

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This matter having come regularly on for hearing before the above entitled Court on December 17, 1942, based on written petition and on order of this Court of October 20, 1942 fixing December 17, 1942 as the date for hearing on said petition, and after the Court had heard testimony under oath in support of said petition by Oscar A. Piper, civil ongineer, L. C. Bell, chief engineer of the Department of Fisheries, R. C. Meigs, Biologist of the Department of Game, Clarenco Hickey, Snohomish County Engineer, Tom W. Holman, and E. B. Enllinger, and after there had been offered and received in evidence Exhibits "A" to "F", both inclusive; and no objection or exception to the granting of the prayer of the said petition having been filed herein, or having been made in open court; and at the conclusion of said hearing the Court having made and entered herein its findings of fact and conclusions of law; now, based on said findings of fact and conclusions. of law, and the Court being fully advised, IT IS DETERMINED, ADJUDGED AND ORDERED by way of final
