

Most common questions the city is asked about Tour de Terrace:

1. What is their website? www.tourdeterrace.org
2. How do I get there? In 2019, there is MAJOR construction on 236th Street SW from I-5 to 56th Avenue. Please use 220th Street and the 228th Street Overpass to reach 58th and 56th Avenues if coming from I-5 or the west side of I-5.
3. Is it free? Yes (admission, music, car show, parade, fireworks show)
4. What charges are there? (Carnival rides/games, food, drinks, items for purchase)
5. What time does the parade start? 6:45 p.m.
6. What time does the parade end? Usually by 8:30 p.m.
7. What is the parade route? Northbound on 56th Avenue West from 234th Street SW to Evergreen Playfield at 222nd Street SW
8. When does 56th and the parade staging area (near the Civic Campus) close? Roughly about 5:00 p.m.
9. Where do I check in for the parade if I'm in it? East of the Civic Campus Parking Lot (corner of 232nd Street SW and 58th Avenue West) on back side of the strip mall.
10. Where is Tour de Terrace? Evergreen Playfield Complex, 22205 56th Avenue West
11. When does the carnival begin? Friday at 2:00 p.m.
12. How much are the rides? (See the Tour de Terrace website)
13. When/where is the fireworks show? 10:00 p.m. on Saturday night from the south end of the festival
14. Where is the street fair? 224th Street SW, east of 56th Avenue
15. Where can I park? St. Pius Church charges for parking nearby or on the street parking
16. When/where is the classic car show? Saturday from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m., field south of the carnival
17. What kind of food and vendors do they have there? (See the Tour de Terrace website)
18. When/where is the 5K run/walk? At Mountlake Terrace High School, Saturday, 8:30 a.m.
19. What bands are playing? (See the Tour de Terrace website)

20. The bands play at the bandstand on the northern most field (baseball field), beer garden and food booths are also here. There are covered areas with tables and chairs.
21. When is the pancake breakfast? Saturday and Sunday, 8:00 a.m. to noon
22. When does Tour de Terrace end? Sunday at 6:00 p.m.
23. Reminders from your fellow residents: Please pick up your trash (including candy & wrappers during parade), be considerate of neighbors and their properties, and keep your children and pets out of the street during the parade.
