Purpose of Town Center Plan:

Create a framework for a vibrant downtown, with thriving businesses, walkability, and quality of life for residents

Council Goals:

The City Council's goals for economic development and community outreach have set the stage for developing a Town Center Plan.

Examples of questions the Town Center Plan will answer:

- □ What is the vision for downtown?
- □ What kinds of development will work best here?
- ☐ Where should the main "core" Town Center be located—and how will it be different than other parts of the existing downtown business district?
- ☐ How can design standards ensure quality development AND meet market needs?
- □ How can traffic impacts be addressed?
- ☐ Where could a new city hall be located and should it have space for a community center or other uses?
- ☐ How can nearby residential neighborhoods be protected while more downtown development is encouraged?
- □ Should mini-casinos be allowed?
- ☐ How can the city's location on I-5 be used to advantage?



Proposed Timeframe:

The City Council has set a fast-paced schedule for developing and finalizing a **Town Center Plan by the end of 2006**, along with any necessary code changes. Following is a schedule of major milestones.
